New Fire Alarm System

The school has been successful in our bid to Staffordshire County Council for an upgrade of the Fire Alarm system, to replace the current system which has been in operation since school opened in the 1980s. 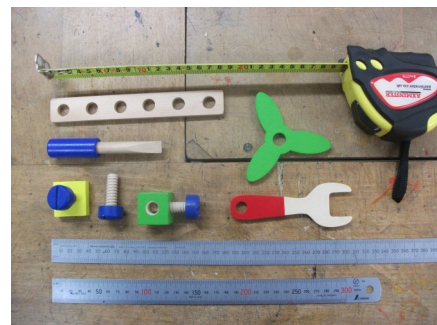
Car Park
