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Dear Parents and Carers,

I trust that you are all well and have enjoyed your summer holiday.

When we wrote to you at the end of last term, we promised to update you this week about our plans for re-opening the school for the Autumn term. We want everyone to be back in school fulltime as soon as possible, but we do need to proceed carefully to keep everyone safe.

We have already set up two transition days on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th September, when year 7 pupils, our post 16 groups and pupils in our Complex Needs classes will be in school.

Having reviewed the latest advice from the Government and our plans to keep pupils separate in school, we have decided that we need to extend our transitional arrangements for longer to ensure that our new systems work safely. I know that this will be difficult for many of you and I am sorry that this is necessary, but I do need to feel confident that the safety systems we put in place work effectively before we have everyone back in school all at the same time.

For the next four weeks, we will be having around half of the pupils in school each day. We will run a two week timetable so that each group has a week when they are in school three days a week and then one when they are in school two days a week. The timetable will stay the same each week, with Wednesday being the day that is different.

If you feel that you meet the Government's criteria for Critical Workers, please do let us know and we will be in touch to make sure that arrangements are made for your child to attend school every day.


Mr Liaquat will be in touch with students in our Nurture group to confirm their arrangements for this period.
